## SECTION 1 – MEMBERSHIP DUES

### 1.01 Membership Options

### 1.02 Membership Payment

## SECTION 2 – MEMBER CONDUCT

As adopted by the Board of Directors, Canada Bikes defines the following member conduct.

### 2.01 Member in Good Standing

The member is deemed to be in good standing if his/her conduct is accordance to the articles, By-law Sections 2. and 3. including the payment of membership dues as per By-law Section 3.01 and other relevant sections, and Section 1 – Membership Dues of this Member Policy.

### 2.02. Member Not in Good Standing

A member is deemed by the Board of Directors, at its sole discretion, to be not in good standing when:

- membership dues are in default as per By-law Section 3.01; or
- written or electronic notice of suspension or expulsion has been sent as per By-law Section 3.03

A member not in good standing does not have voting rights at member meetings including Annual General Meetings and may not be elected or acclaimed as a Director, Officer, Committee or Advisory Member of Canada Bikes.
